Prevea Health Mammography Receives Accreditation

All four Prevea Health locations providing mammography services recently passed their annual FDA inspection. The three metro health centers—Allouez, East DePere and St. Mary's—all passed their inspection in June, and the Oconto facility passed its inspection in July. “These inspections are mandated through the Mammography Quality Standards Act of 1992, or MQSA,” said Ellen Greenlund, Radiology Manager at Prevea Health, “and our facilities continue to pass with flying colors.”

In addition, the Prevea Health Allouez Health Center in Green Bay has been awarded a three-year term of accreditation in mammographic imaging as a result of a recent survey by the American College of Radiology (ACR). The ACR awards accreditation to facilities for the achievement of high practice standards. Board-certified physicians and medical physicists who are experts in the field conduct the evaluations. They assess the qualifications of the personnel and the adequacy of facility equipment. All Prevea mammography sites meet current accreditation standards with the ACR, with renewals in different years.

“These are rigorous inspections of quality, staff, radiologists and equipment,” said Greenlund, “so we are pleased to be officially recognized for the quality service provided at Prevea Health. That we annually pass our FDA inspections with high marks shows that we truly strive to provide the best in patient care.”
